## Jesus cannot stand people being mistreated

There was a gradation of humanity in the ancient world. It is still practiced in our world. Gradations on the basis of wealth, education, status, rank, castes, class, ethnicity, race, gender – we see many ways this still plays out in many parts of our world.

"We must never forget this as a nation: there are no gradations in the image of God." ~ Dr Martin Luther King, Jr. Notes: The Great Banquet The original invitees make excuses. But the Master is still going to have a party. He tells His servant, "Go out quickly." There is urgency in the Master's invitation. Drop everything and make this your top priority – go and tell people to come to the party! Notes:

Turns out there are a lot of chairs because this is one big party. It is unthinkable that we can sit here and enjoy the blessings and riche of knowing God and keep it all to ourselves.				
Notes:				
Jesus has not stopped sending His servants out. To this day, in this very region, He is saying to His servants:  Who are the ones who think they cannot come in?  Go tell them. Give a compelling witness to them.  Tell them Jesus is their source. He is their purpose. He is their goal.  Tell them there is a place they can come and reimagine their future.  Tell them the Master has invited them to a feast.  And in this party all that was broken can now be reconciled and made whole. This is what we proclaim. We proclaim Him and the fact that He is leading a Resurrection Party.  And that there is still room at the party.
