# WELCOME TO 40 DAYS OF ADVENTURE!

Adventure can be defined as an unusual, exciting, even hazardous experience or activity. In the Bible, 40 is often a spiritually significant time period. It seems God often uses this time frame on purpose, with purpose, for a purpose -- often to invite people into deeper relationship with him.

Noah's life and the entire world was altered by 40 days of rain. Moses spent 40 days in the presence of God on Mt. Sinai. The spies spent 40 days "spying out" the promised land. David was transformed by Goliath's 40-day challenge. Elijah was strengthened by just one meal from God for 40 days. The entire city of Nineveh was transformed when God gave the people 40 days to change or else.... Jesus launched his ministry after being baptized and spending 40 days fasting in the wilderness. Finally, the disciples



were transformed after spending 40 days with the crucified and risen Christ. You are being invited on such an adventure: to spend 40 days putting into practice "Living the Five."

USE IT DURING THE MESSAGE SERIES TO WRITE DOWN A KEY THOUGHT WHEN LISTENING TO THAT WEEK'S MESSAGE, BUT IT'S MOSTLY MEANT FOR YOU TO ENGAGE WITH GOD, QUIETLY EACH DAY DURING THE WEEK BETWEEN MESSAGES WEEK BY WEEK THE MESSAGE SERIES TOPICS WILL GIVE YOU INSIGHTS ON HOW TO PRACTICALLY LIVE OUT "THE FIVE" (WHICH ACTUALLY ARE "SEVEN"), WE'VE GROUPED THE FIRST FOUR AS TWO SETS OF TWO, BECAUSE THEY **GO WELL TOGETHER** WHEN LIVING OUT THE CHRISTIAN LIFE. BESIDES, WHILE

seven is one of God's perfect numbers, "Living the Five" just sounds so 'cool', 'fire', 'Gucci', or 'slay', if you catch my drift. Why are these next 40 days important? One of the things we are confronted with in reading the Bible is the brevity of our lives and the importance of how we spend each and every day. Psalm 90:12 says, "Teach us to realize the brevity of life, so that we may grow in wisdom." God wants every day to be our best. He also wants what's best for each of us



## DID YOU KNOW... THAT THE AVERAGE LIFE EXPECTANCY IN THE UNITED STATES IS 28.124 DAYS?

That equates to four thousand weekends. Most of us don't start living self-directed lives until our late teens or right at the cusp of age 20. Do the math and that equates to roughly one thousand weekends, leaving the average adult three thousand weekends to spend in pursuit of whatever it is they deem most important in life.

Our time is precious and important. I can't help but think of a song released back in 1980 by the Canadian pop band Loverboy, titled 'Working for the Weekend' (check it out on YouTube, Spotify, or your fav).

"When People do not Accept divine Guidance, They RUN WILD..." PROVERBS 29:18 NLT



This song with its simple lyrics, and especially the chorus which starts with the line, "Everybody's working for the weekend," captures the mundane routine most of us get caught up in - working hard all week, waiting for the weekend to arrive so we can "live."

This was never what God intended for any of us! He has plans for you. He built you for a purpose. That's what this God-adventure is all about. Life is a journey, not a destination. It's about discovery, transformation, and truly living on the way - God's way.

# +READ

TAKE TIME TO READ THE BIBLE VERSES FOR A GIVEN DAY - PREFERABLY FROM AN ANALOGUE (PRINTED) BIBLE. WE RECOMMEND THE NEW LIVING TRANSLATION VERSION (NLT). IF YOU DON'T OWN A PRINTED BIBLE, THE CHURCH WILL GLADLY PROVIDE ONE FOR YOU TO KEEP. USING A PRINTED BIBLE WILL HELP YOU LOCATE WHAT YOU ARE READING IN THE LARGER CONTEXT OF THE **BIBLE - WHICH BOOK THE VERSES ARE IN AND** WHERE THAT BOOK SITS IN RELATIONSHIP TO ALL THE OTHER BOOKS OF THE BIBLE. YOU WILL TRULY EXPERIENCE THE VERSES AS YOU HOLD THE BIBLE. FLIP THROUGH THE BIBLE. FEELING THE PAGES IN YOUR HAND WHILE DOING SO. YOU ARE ENCOURAGED TO READ THE LARGER CONTEXT OF EACH VERSE, SUCH AS VERSES AROUND THE VERSE YOU'VE READ, THE CHAPTER IN WHICH IT RESIDES, OR EVEN PORTIONS OF THE BOOK (SOME ARE LETTERS and quick reads) - you decide or let God GUIDE YOU BASED UPON THE TIME YOU HAVE EACH DAY.



# READ YOUR BIBLE



FULFILLMENT AND INTERPRETATION OF ALL GOD REVEALED TO ISRAEL IN THE OLD TESTAMENT. SUCH CLAIMS MOVE BEYOND SIMPLY HELPING US NAVIGATE LIFE'S CHALLENGES AND MAKING DIVINELY-GUIDED DECISIONS (WHICH THE BIBLE DOES QUITE WELL). THEY PROMISE SALVATION, TRANSFORMATION, AND REVELATION.

### +REMINDER:

Each day this week we will read verses from either the Old Testament, the New Testament, or both which speak to what the Bible has to say about itself. Every day our approach will be to **read** that day's verses, then to **reflect** on them by writing down your thoughts or impressions in the space provided, then to **respond** to God in a short conversational written prayer in the space provided. Finally, we will end each day's quiet time with a verse to **remember** and ponder throughout our day.

THROUGH PRAYER, WE DEVELOP A DEEP, PERSONAL RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD, EXPERIENCING HIS PRESENCE, RECEIVING, HIS COMFORT AND PEACE. SADLY, MANY VIEW PRAYER AS AN "ERSY BUTTON" TO BE PUSHED, RATHER THAN A RELATIONSHIP TO BE PURSUED. WELL, YES, IT DOES. BUT PRAYER DOESN'T WORK BECAUSE | GOT WHAT | WANTED. GOD IS SOVEREIGN. HE DOESN'T RESPOND TO OUR EVERY WHIM AND PRAYER WITH A "YES" IF HE DID, THE WORLD WOULD BE A CHAOTIC MESS. WELL THEN, HOW DOES PRAYER WORK? "NEVER STOP PRAYING." ~ 1 THESSALONIANS 5:17 19 Survival Journal.


> TAKE TIME TO PRAY

ONLY GOD KNOWS. TO BE SURE, PRAYER DOES 'WORK', BUT IT WORKS VERY DIFFERENTLY THAN WE'D LIKE IT TO. SOME PRAYERS ARE CONDITIONAL, OTHERS REQUIRE PERSISTENCE (MATTHEW 7:7). SOME PRAYERS ARE MEANT TO BE DONE (MATTHEW 7:7). SOME PRAYERS ARE MEANT TO BE DONE CORPORATELY, OTHERS PRIVATELY. SOME STUATIONS REQUIRE MUCH PRAYER, FAITH & EVEN FASTING - JESUS SAYS SO (MATTHEW 17:20-21; MARK 9:29).

• THIS WEEX. AS WE PROBE THE BIBLE AND READ VERSES ABOUT PRAYER, NOTICE VORDS UKE 'IF, 'WHEN,' HUMBLE,' GWE AND 'FORGIVE.'' THE BIBLE SAYS GOD HEARS OUR PRAYERS. JESUS EXPECTS US TO PRAY ('WHEN PRAYERS. 

# WALLER PEAKING #3

"For this is how God loved the world: He gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life." John 3:16

THIS MIGHT SEEM TO BE A STRANGE VERSE TO USE AS OUR BEARING POINT FOR THIS WEEK'S TOPIC, GIVING, ALONG OUR JOURNEY. BUT LET'S TAKE A MOMENT TO CONSIDER JOHN 3:16. NOTICE HOW THE VERSE UNFOLDS, 1) GOD - THE GREATEST LOVER, 2) "LOVED," TO THE GREATEST DEGREE, 3) "THE WORLD," THE GREATEST NUMBER, 4) THAT "HE GAVE," THE GREATEST ACT, 5) "HIS ONE AND ONLY SON," THE GREATEST GIFT, 6) "SO THAT EVERYONE," THE GREATEST INVITATION, 7) "WHO BELIEVES," THE GREATEST SIMPLICITY, 8) "IN HIM," THE GREATEST PERSON, 9) "WILL NOT perish," the greatest deliverance, 10) "but," the greatest difference, 11) "have" THE GREATEST CERTAINTY, 12) "ETERNAL LIFE," THE GREATEST POSSESSION.

WE SEE INTENSE **GENEROSITY AT THE HEART** OF THIS TEXT. WE OFTEN THINK OF GETTING, NOT GIVING, TO GAIN GREAT POSSESSIONS. IT TURNS OUT. WE HAVE BEEN OFFERED THE GREATEST POSSESSION OF ALL, AND IT'S A FREE GIFT. This is the heart of Christianity: A GRACIOUS, GIVING, AND FORGIVING GOD, WHO FREELY OFFERS TO EACH ONE OF US. in the person of his Son - eternal LIFE. AS SUCH, GENEROSITY AND GIVING ARE CENTRAL TO THE CHRISTIAN LIFE. THE ACT OF GIVING HELPS US ACKNOWLEDGE THAT EVERYTHING WE HAVE IS A GIFT FROM THE CREATOR: THAT WE ARE CUSTODIANS ENTRUSTED WITH RESOURCES TO BLESS OTHERS. GIVING CULTIVATES A SPIRIT OF GRATITUDE AND CONTENTMENT IN THE GIVER. GOD WANTS US TO GIVE AS HE DID, NOT RELUCTANTLY or out of compulsion (2 Corinthians 9:7). WHEN WE GIVE TO OTHERS OR THE CHURCH, WE are partnering with God, participating in His work. Such giving has an impact beyond OUR IMMEDIATE SPHERE - EVEN BEYOND OUR OWN LIFETIME.







Make a positive impact on the community and for others WITH YOUR TIME, TALENTS, AND TREASURE. 6) INVITE OTHERS INTO COMMUNITY - YOUR SMALL GROUP, FRIEND GROUP, TO CHURCH & EVENTS. 7) Ask good questions and listen well. The Bible recommends THAT WE SHOULD "BE QUICK TO LISTEN AND SLOW TO SPEAK." Only share if your friend is receptive to hear what you have to say. Ask what your friend thinks about Jesus, THE BIBLE, AND CHRISTIANITY.\*


