## **SERMON NOTES:**

One day Jesus was praying in a certain place.

When he finished, one of his disciples said to him,

"Lord, teach us to pray, just as John taught his disciples."

He said to them, "When you pray, say:

"Father, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come.

Give us each day our daily bread.

Forgive us our sins,

for we also forgive everyone who sins against us.

And lead us not into temptation."

"So I say to you: Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives; the one who seeks finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened.

"Which of you fathers, if your son asks for a fish, will give him a snake instead? Or if he asks for an egg, will give him a scorpion? If you then, though you are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him!"

# Two Big Ideas:

- 1. God has given you <u>everything</u> you need to live the life <u>He has called you to live</u>.
- 2. The <u>degree</u> to which we experience God's Spirit is <u>dependent</u> on our level of dependence.

# Big Idea #1: God has given you <u>everything</u> you need to live the life He has called you to live.

"But the Advocate, the **Holy Spirit**, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you."

"His divine power has granted to us <u>all things</u> that pertain to life and godliness."  $\sim 2 \text{ Peter } 1:3 \text{ (ESV)}$ 

The Holy Spirit...

Counsels us in the way we should go,
Comforts us in our hurt,
Convicts us of sin and our need for a Savior,
Illuminates truth of Scripture,
Indwells (takes up residence in) us
as adopted sons and daughters of God,
Teaches us the wisdom of God,
Empowers us to resist sin and become more like Jesus,
Equips us with spiritual gifts to accomplish our life purpose,
Encourages us with hope and the promises of God,
Unites the diverse Body of Christ together in community.

"But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control...Those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires.

Since we live by the Spirit, let us **keep in step** with the Spirit."

## Big Idea #2:

The <u>degree</u> to which we experience God's Spirit is <u>dependent</u> on our level of dependence.

As we empty ourselves, we are filled.

<u>Dependence</u> often requires <u>discomfort</u>.

"Do not get drunk on wine, which leads to debauchery.
Instead, be (continually) filled with the Spirit."

- Continually pray throughout the day for Holy Spirit "eyes" to see what God is doing around you and to walk in the good works that He has prepared for you.
