In my former book, Theophilus, I wrote about all that Jesus began to do and to teach until the day he was taken up to heaven, after giving instructions through the Holy Spirit to the apostles he had chosen. Acts 1:1-2

• <u>Theophilus</u> – <u>loved</u> by God, <u>friend</u> of God

With this in mind, since I myself have carefully investigated everything from the beginning, I too decided to write an orderly account for you, most excellent Theophilus, so that you may know the certainty of the things you have been taught.

Luke 1:3-4

 - High ranking **Roman Official**
 - Paul's attorney
 - Jewish High Priest
 - <u>Wealthy</u> and influential <u>business</u> person
 - <u>Honorary</u> Title
- <u>Why</u> was Luke writing these letters to him?
 - Theophilus was seeking after God
