• Is the Bible <u>true</u>?

- With all the **translating** of the Bible, how do we know it is still **accurate**?
 - The <u>Talmudim</u> A.D. 100-500
 - The <u>Massoretes</u> A.D. 500-900
 - The discovery of the <u>Dead Sea Scrolls</u> in 1947

The Lord said to me, "You have seen correctly, for I am watching to see that my word is fulfilled." Jeremiah 1:12

- The <u>Bible</u> is the most <u>accurately</u> translated book of all time
 - The <u>number</u> of manuscripts available
 - The <u>time interval</u> from the original to the manuscript
 - The **<u>quality</u>** of the manuscript

Julius Caesar – The <u>Gallic</u> Wars Plato – <u>Tetralogies</u> Homer – The <u>Iliad</u> The <u>New Testament</u> All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work. 2 Timothy 3:16-17

- It may be **accurate** but how do we know it is **true**?
 - <u>Archaeological</u> evidence
 - <u>Historical</u> evidence
 - <u>Scientific</u> evidence
 - Prophetic evidence
