Galatians 5:22-23

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, ²³ gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law.

Jesus brings joy

- o <u>Joy</u> is internal, <u>happiness</u> is circumstantial
- Joy is an <u>aspect</u> of God's being
- 1. Enemies of Joy
 - Unresolved <u>Guilt</u>
 Psalms 51:12 "Restore to me the joy of your salvation"
 - Wounded Ego
 1 Peter 5:5 "All of you, clothe yourselves with Humility toward one another..."
 - Ego is a form of pride and we need the opposite which is humility
 - Unpleasant Circumstances
 - Even though your <u>circumstances</u> are unpleasant God still wants to give you Joy
 - Nehemiah 8:10 "for the joy of the Lord is my strength"
- 2. Jesus the perfect example of joy
 - John 15:11 "These things I have spoken to you so that my joy may be in you, and that your joy may be made full."
 - On the last night of His life, facing the cross, Jesus talks about love and joy
- 3. How can we experience that kind of joy?

John 15:5-6

"I am the vine; you are the branches. If a man remains in me and I in him, he will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing. If anyone does not remain in me, he is like a branch that is thrown away and withers; such branches are picked up, thrown into the fire and hurned"

- <u>Develop</u> and <u>maintain</u> a personal relationship with Jesus
- Read the word of God
- Attend church and get <u>plugged</u> into a community group
- Give of ourselves in service for others
- Focus on the <u>eternal</u> not the <u>temporal</u>
