DAY 10

Encountering the holiness of God is a terrifying thing. Read Isaiah 6: 1-7.

Place yourself in Isaiah's shoes for a minute. Try to imagine the sight of God's Throne and His pure and utter holiness. But what does holiness really mean? At its core the word conveys the complete lack of sin and corruption. But God's holiness means more than that. His holiness places God on a completely separate level from us. By associating with us, God would be stained because of our un-holiness. That is what makes the offer of salvation so amazing. God chose to allow His Son to be covered with the stain of our sin. All the ugliness of the world was placed on Jesus at the cross.

But just like Isaiah was freed from the corruption of sin by the live coal burning the stain of sin away, Jesus took our sins. Take some time to consider God's amazing love in this action.

Now read Isaiah 6: 8-10.

God's redemption of us is for a reason. That reason lies in our calling to go and tell. Who is God calling you to tell of His love?
