## A GIFT OF PEACE

as you go

These are simple questions to ask your student as you go home from church or go about your weekly activities.

**.01** Who do you go to when you need advice or wisdom? Why?

**.02** When do you feel most peaceful in your life? What situations, places, or people bring you peace? What is peaceful about them?

family DEVOTION

Consider following up with your student later in the week with the following summary and discussion questions.

summary: JOHN 14:16-29

As Jesus continued to share His final teachings with His disciples, He revealed that after He was gone, He would send the Holy Spirit to be their counselor and the Spirit of truth. The Holy Spirit is probably the most misunderstood out of the three persons of the Trinity—a concept that is already difficult for us to wrap our minds around—so pay close attention to what Jesus teaches here. In today's passage, Jesus taught about the relationship between the Father, the Son, and the Spirit, and He explained that the Holy Spirit will be with His disciples to remind us about everything that Jesus taught.

discussion QUESTIONS

**.01** What did you learn about the three persons of the Trinity in this week's session? What role does the Holy Spirit have?

**.02** How does following Jesus give you access to His peace? What does this peace look like for you?

**PRAY:** Thank God for the mystery of the Trinity and how they actively uphold God's people. Ask God to grow your relationship with the Father, the Son, and the Spirit, even when you don't fully understand.
