as you go

These are simple questions to ask your student as you go home from church or go about your weekly activities.

- When was the last time you had to say good-bye to someone important to you? Who was it? How did it make you feel?

family **DEVOTION**

Consider following up with your student later in the week with the following summary and discussion questions.

SUMMARY: JOHN 15:26-27; 16:7-15

The Holy Spirit has many different roles and titles: Counselor, Helper, Advocate, Spirit of truth, and Comforter, to name a few. Jesus explained that part of the Spirit's role was to testify—tell the truth—about Him to the world, and another part was to convict the world about sin, righteousness, and judgment. Finally, He shared that the Spirit would guide the disciples in the truth, point their eyes towards Jesus, and show the world Jesus's true worth.

discussion QUESTIONS

- Why was it important that Jesus was sending the Spirit? How might this have comforted and encouraged the disciples?
- What are some ways the Spirit has worked in your life? What are some ways you can watch for His work over the next week?

PRAY: Thank God that He did not leave us alone, but sent the Spirit to be with us, guide us, and remind us of God's truths. Ask the Spirit to show you how He is working in your life and in the life of the church.
