We are to lay aside the sin and deceptions and inconsistencies of our flesh and soak up the word of God. One of our babies would begin to panic if they were not fed in time. As parents, we learned to not mess around because when panic went too far, it could take hours to calm the baby down. There was a sense of urgency! There needs to be a sense of urgency in our desire to feed on God's word! Spending time reading, meditating, learning, memorizing God's word is a mark of His discipleship.

There is a little prep work. To pick up His word and feast on it, we must put some things down! We are to lay aside "malice, deceit, hypocrisy, envy, and evil speaking." We can't carry both. We have a decision to make. Will we cling to the things that are unhealthy? Or will we cling to that which satisfies our soul, His word!

Do you value God's word? Is God's word a priority in your life? Do you live with a hunger for His word? Do you spend time daily reading His word? I want to invite you to make it a daily commitment.
