Read Luke 10: 1-12.

Imagine the feeling among the disciples when Jesus sent them out on this mission. They are to go unprepared materially for a trip. They don't have a planned place to stay. Imagine your family is planning a trip to another state. Instead of securing hotel reservations, you simply plan to stay with someone you will hopefully meet. Instead of carefully determining how much money it will take to purchase food, you plan to eat whatever is offered to you. That is what the disciples were facing.

And even more worrying, they are supposed to find a "man of peace" to whom they will explain the most important message ever. How will they find this individual? Our mission to share the hope of Jesus in Sanger and beyond relies on the same practice. Who in your neighborhood is that "man of peace" who could help make introductions to all who live in your neighborhood. I don't mean the nosy neighbor everyone secretly dreads seeing. I mean the person everyone smiles when they see.

Ask God to help you see this individual. Then ask God to give you the spiritual strength to meet him/ her and share the good news of Jesus.
