as you go

These are simple questions to ask your students as you go home from church or go about your weekly activities.

.01 Think about a time you were humbled or brought low. What happened?

.02 Think back to a big accomplishment in your life: Who helped you get there? Why is it important to remember the people who help us along the way?

family DEVOTION

Consider following up with your student later in the week with the following summary and discussion questions.

summary: DANIEL 4:28-37

All of us struggle with pride. It comes in many shapes and sizes, and throughout our lives, the Lord will give us reminders of it. Despite our hard work, put-together lives, and moral merit badges, God alone will receive ultimate glory. Nebuchadnezzar had been warned that he would be humbled because of his pride, and in this week's passage we will see God's judgment against him finally come to pass. As we read about Nebuchadnezzar's experience, we will be reminded that God will humble our prideful hearts.

discussion QUESTIONS

.01 What can you learn from Nebuchadnezzar about the dangers of pride? Why does God call us to give Him glory instead?

.02 What are some areas of your life where you are failing to give credit to God for your successes? Where do you need to practice more humility?

PRAY: Ask God to show you any ways that you are being prideful or focused on your own "kingdom." Give these to Him and ask Him to teach you what it means to serve Him humbly using the gifts He has given you.
