In the Old Testament there are many laws and commands given. Those laws help us see what God demands of His people. As followers of Jesus, we are not bound to the law for our salvation. We are saved by grace, not law. But that doesn't mean the teachings of the law are negated in our lives. One command of God found in the Old Testament is the Law of Sabbath. This command was actually given by God before Moses. It comes from the creation account where we are told God created everything in 6 days and rested on the seventh. From that principle of God resting on the seventh day, we are given the command to take one day for rest and worship. Our society runs at a seven-day pace. Most of us work more than five days, typically leaving us one day for family activities, chores around the house and church attendance. How do we prioritize that one day? Our society will quickly fill that one day with activities if we don't make worship and fellowship with God's people the priority. I am writing this because I too often fail to practice the Sabbath of rest. It eventually catches up with all of us. Don't let the world entice you into forgetting to take one day to rest and worship with God's people.

Being a disciple means learning to serve. Where will you serve God and His church? Find a place to give your time, talents and treasure. Serving is the path to greatness in God's Kingdom. Get on that path.

- 4. setting up and managing props for the various stations;
- 5. costumes;
- 6. communications and advertising;
- 7. traffic control and security;
- 8. stage crew;
- 9. lighting and sound support;
- 10. lots of people to return the outdoor scene and props to their storage locations after the production.

Some people can help in multiple areas, and we'll need that. But, almost everybody can do something, and that's what we need!
