Scriptural basis:

Proverbs 3:5-6 / Luke 6:37 / Matthew 6:5 / Matthew 6:9-13

Review text and jot down anything that caught your attention as you watched episode 1.

When Jesus was detained He told the disciples, "I will be back". In a frenzy, the disciples are wanting to take matters into their own hands. Do you have a tendency to do the same? Mary quotes Proverbs 3:5-6, how does this scripture guide you through that?

Peter tells Andrew that he should fish because Jesus told them to. "Do as he says or bad things will happen." How does this reveal a sad reality to their thoughts about Jesus at this point in their relationship? Do you ever struggle with similar thoughts?

Jesus' constant calmness (and his modeling solitary prayer) convinces the disciples to ask Him to teach them how to pray. How did this scene impact you?
