POINT: To STAY in the Son SHOWS We Belong to God's Family

How did God speak to you through Sunday's message?

1. Read 1 John 2:28-3:10.

What statements or verses encouraged you most and why?

Conversely, which raised questions?

- 2. In 1 John 2:28, John wants us to have confidence in the presence of Christ when we stand before him. Discuss ways we find this assurance amplified in 3:1-3?
  - In v3, John says this hope in him causes us to purify ourselves, just as he is pure. In your experience, is this hope (or hopefulness) a present and vital part of Christian experience? Why or why not?
  - In practice, how should we deploy this hope and its power to transform our thought life and purify our conduct?
- 3. How would we instruct a new believer to stay (abide or remain) in Christ (v28)? Read John 15:4-11 for the source of John's use of stay (Greek: menō) in the teaching of Jesus.
- 4. Across this passage (2:28-3:10), discuss why doing or practicing sin is so serious? Read the following passages and discuss them:

Read 3:2-3 Read 3:5 and 8 5. Discuss the significance of v9 and the meaning of the words, because his seed remains (menō: stays, abides) in him. The seed is God's Spirit (see John 3:5-8; 1 John 3:24 and 2:20, 27).
