4. What does it say about the incarnation and Jesus' death (see 1:7 and 2:1-2) if we deny our sin?

POINT: WALKING in The Light CONFORMS us to the Character of God

How did God speak to you through Sunday's message?

- 1. Read 1 John 1:5-2:2. Take turns and share one of John's thoughts that speak powerfully to you and why.
- 2. In this passage (1:5-2:2), there is an emphasis upon the necessary admission of sin in our lives. Give examples and discuss.

Using John's words, discuss the ramifications of denying sin and our sinfulness.

Why should an awareness and admission of our sin (or sinfulness) be important to God's character as The Light and our fellowship in The Light?

3. Read 1 John 1:9 and 2:1-2. Discuss these verses and highlight individual insights and encouragement.

5. Read 1 John 2:1-2. What does it mean to you when John stresses, "and not only for ours, but also for those of the whole world"?
