Romans 1:19-21

MAIN POINT: We believe God created everything for His glory

1. God is the Beginning-Genesis 1:1, Psalm 90:2, Job 38:4-7

Do you feel like God plays hide and seek with us? What can we learn about God from nature? How does God communicate through our world? Why is the "natural world" not enough to know God? Why do you think some people don't believe in a creator? How might you talk with a non-believer about God being the Creator of all things?

2. God is the only creator-Nehemiah 9:5b-6, Psalm 19:1-4

How does God being the creator put him in a category by himself? Why is knowing the Creator/Creature distinction important? What does it mean to you that you didn't create yourself and are a creature with a creator? Why do you think we forget about our creatureliness? What are ways that we can remind ourselves about our creatureliness?

3. God created for His glory- Revelation 4:11, Psalm 148:1-6

What does it mean to glorify God? How does honoring and giving him thanks bring him glory? How does this relate to our purpose in life? How can you help others who think life is meaningless? How can you live out in some practical ways to glorify God and teach others such as children to do the same?
