R-Group Questions

Psalm 2

MAIN POINT: God rules the nations through His anointed King

I. Nations REBEL against God's authority (1-3)

Do you think we are natural rebels? Why do you think this is the case?

Discuss Ephesians 2:1-4, what fundamental truth is this teaching? How does this relate to us?

What examples of rebellion against God's authority do you see? In your own life and heart?

II. God's RESPONSE (4-9)

How did Jesus fulfill this Psalm, is fulfilling it and will fulfill this Psalm?

What does it mean that Jesus is King? For your life? For our country? For our world?

How does the perspective of God's rule change when you take account that our King died for us?

III. RECEIVE the True King (10-12)

How does seeking the Kingdom of God first reframe everything else? Think about your life, how does the perspective about your job, your family life, your hobbies, your time, your money change in light of the priority of the Kingdom?

What prevents us from putting first the Kingdom of God first in our lives?

Was there anything else that you learned, were challenged by, or were encouraged through the sermon?
