

Day 1:

Scripture: "By faith Moses' parents hid him for three months after he was born, because they saw he was no ordinary child, and they were not afraid of the king's edict." - Hebrews 11:23

Reflection: How can you demonstrate courageous faith in your parenting or relationships today?

Application: Identify one area where you need to trust God more in raising your children or influencing others. Take a step of faith in that area.

Prayer: Lord, give me courage to parent and lead others according to Your ways, not the ways of the world. Help me to trust You more.

Day 2:

Scripture: "These commandments that I give you today are to be on your hearts. Impress them on your children." - Deuteronomy 6:6-7a

Reflection: What spiritual truths or values are you consistently teaching and modeling for your children or those you influence?

Application: Choose one Biblical truth to intentionally discuss and demonstrate this week with your family or those close to you.

Prayer: Father, help me to diligently teach Your truths to my children and others. May my life reflect Your Word.

Day 3:

Scripture: "Start children off on the way they should go, and even when they are old they will not turn from it." - Proverbs 22:6

Reflection: How are you guiding your children or others intellectually and practically, not just spiritually?

Application: Have a conversation with your child or someone you mentor about how their faith applies to their education or work.

Prayer: God, give me wisdom to guide those in my care in all areas of life. Help me integrate faith into every aspect.

Day 4:

Scripture: "Children are a heritage from the Lord, offspring a reward from him." - Psalm 127:3

Reflection: Do you view your children or those you influence as gifts from God to be stewarded, not possessions to control?

Application: Release control in one area where you tend to be overprotective. Trust God more with those in your care.

Prayer: Lord, thank you for entrusting me with children and relationships. Help me to steward them well while trusting You.

Day 5:

Scripture: "Train up a child in the way he should go; even when he is old he will not depart from it." - Proverbs 22:6

Reflection: Are you consistently modeling and teaching godly character and work ethic to your children or those you lead?

Application: Assign a new chore or responsibility to your child to help develop their work ethic and life skills.

Prayer: Father, help me to train up the next generation to honor You through godly character and diligent work. May I model this myself.
