

2 Samuel 15

Gossip...

- 1. ... is a serious sin
- 2. ... is like murder in that one's character is assassinated
- 3. ... grieves the heart of God
- 4. ... comes from a narcissistic and arrogant perspective
- 5. ... reveals a man's immaturity
- 6. ... is an outer indication of an inner deficiency
- 7. ... is like a sharp knife stabbing the back of another
- 8. ... is one-sided and at least partially a lie
- 9. ... is a polar opposite of the gospel
- 10. ... is often an attempt to raise oneself up while bringing others down, because the gossip cannot or will not advance on their own merits
- 11. ... is deeply destructive attempt to receive unwarranted affirmation and significance
- 12. ... is often often veiled in some kind of religious prayer request which is weak and sad
- 13. ... is the means by which trustworthiness is annihilated

Proverbs 20:19 A gossip betrays a confidence; so avoid anyone who talks too much.

Proverbs 11:13 A gossip betrays a confidence, but a trustworthy person keeps a secret.

Solutions in Ministering to a "gossip"

- 1. Try to identify the underlying problem and try to meet that need in the "gossip".
- 2. Confront the "gossip" in love and don't be an accomplice to the crime by saying nothing. This does no one any favors.
- 3. Many people are unaware of their sin—but they should be—it is costing them big time.
