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# SMALL GROUP GUIDE

## 1. WELCOME

If anyone has had a significant event in their life this past week, give them a minute to share with the group. If necessary, take some time to pray for any immediate needs right at the beginning of the meeting.

## 2. VISION/PURPOSE

One of our key ingredients of small group is a relational environment, which involves transparency, confidentiality, and accountability. How transparent do you think you are in your group?

## 3. SMALL GROUP GUIDELINES

Review guidelines (Use "I" Statements, No Fixing, Confidentiality, Listening) that cultivate a healthy environment for sharing and discussion.

Use a good mix of Head (informational/study) questions, Heart (personal reflection) questions, and Hand (practical application) questions. Below are questions your group can pick from to follow along with the sermon series.

## 7. PERSONAL SHARING AND PRAYER REQUESTS

You can share and pray in one group, in smaller groups, or in gender specific groups. Make sure that phone numbers are shared so that encouragement and connection can happen during the week.

# QUESTIONS

**WARM UP:** *When was a time that you had to make a decision that stretched your faith? How did you decide what to do? How did it turn out?*

**HEAD:** These questions help us examine the Word.

1. As you meet with your missionary this week, ask them how God led them into the ministry they are in right now. What role did other people play in their decision? What role did strong leaders play? How did the Word of God inspire them or lead them? Which parts? How did God lead in other ways?

**HEART:** These questions help us wrestle with what we believe.

2. Did your missionary ever struggle with doubt about the course they have taken? How did they deal with those doubts? How does this compare with how you handle your doubts?

3. What kinds of circumstances have stretched them the most - whether spiritually or emotionally or any other way? Have they ever wondered if they made the wrong decision? How have they handled these doubts? How do you handle yours?

4. What has been their greatest joy from stepping out in faith? What is yours?

**HAND:** These questions help us bring truth and beliefs into our everyday life.

5. After listening to your missionary, how do you see God leading you with regard to helping in His world-wide mission? How will you decide what God wants you to do? Will it stretch your faith to do what you're thinking about? Is that a good thing or a bad thing?

6. In what ways do you clearly see God's presence in your life? In what ways do you not see it? How can your small group help you see Him more clearly?
