# SMALL GROUP GUIDE

**Write down your observation from today's message:**

### 1. WELCOME

If anyone has had a significant event in their life this past week, give them a minute to share with the group. If necessary, take some time to pray for any immediate needs right at the beginning of the meeting.

### 2. VISION/PURPOSE

As we transition to in-person small groups, talk about how you can stay unified as a group and considerate of those who have different convictions and needs.

### 3. SMALL GROUP GUIDELINES

Review guidelines (Use "I" Statements, No Fixing, Confidentiality, Listening) that cultivate a healthy environment for sharing and discussion.

Use a good mix of Head (informational/study) questions, Heart (personal reflection) questions, and Hand (practical application) questions. Below are questions your group can pick from to follow along with the sermon series.

### 7. PERSONAL SHARING AND PRAYER REQUESTS

You can share and pray in one group, in smaller groups, or in gender specific groups. Make sure that phone numbers are shared so that encouragement and connection can happen during the week.

## QUESTIONS

**WARM UP:** *Recall a journey/trip you've taken. What did your preparation look like? Did the trip go as planned?*

**HEAD:** These questions help us examine the Word.

1. Read Luke 9:1-3 Pretend you are a disciple, and that you are hearing Jesus' words for the first time. What is he asking of you as a disciple?
2. Verse 1 and 2 talk a lot about Spiritual power and authority. Compare this passage with the authority Jesus promised in Matthew 28:18-20. What kind of perspective does Jesus' authority give us?
3. In verse three, Jesus practical call to dependence is profoundly high. Why would He make the disciples journey so demanding?

**HEART:** These questions help us wrestle with what we believe.

4. If you were one of Jesus' 12, would you have fought or embraced living out His call in verses 1-3.
5. What does it look like, (no matter what "journey" Jesus sends you on), to be fully confident in His ability to help you live that calling out?

**HAND:** These questions help us bring truth and beliefs into our everyday life.

6. (From verse 3) How does your life currently line up with the idea of: "I'm going to live out Jesus priorities"?
7. Is your next strong step as a disciple, adding something to your life or taking something away?
