Just as John subverted expectations about true religion, Jesus is subverting expectations about the *kingdom of God*.

Ironically, while John questions Jesus's character, Jesus praises John's. *John's questioning is a longing for the kingdom and it's a virtue*.

We live in a world where the weeds and the wheat grow together, and our hope in Christ is not misplaced.

Continue the conversation:

- Are there expectations that you need to hold more loosely in order to see what God is really doing?
- Who is in the weeds? Make sure they are not alone. Ask God for guidance on how to be present and report about the wheat.
