The central question of the New Testament is not how will I get into heaven?

The heart of the matter is being made _____ with God.

The Trinity conclusions:

God above us: Creator, Father, beyond comprehension.

God for us: Redeemer, Jesus Christ, made things right on our behalf.

God in us: Giver of Life, Holy Spirit, empowers us to say "yes" to God and do good.

The church will always hold to the mystery of the Trinity because the church will never give up on God's grace.

- What does it mean for God to die on the cross?
- What is the good news of God being *above, with, and in us*, for you?
