The Woman at the Well is as opposite from Nicodemus as the authors could have imagined!

This is the longest conversation that Jesus has with anyone in John's Gospel.

Famous marriages in the Bible began at wells: Isaac & Rebecca (Gen. 24); Jacob & Rachel [at midday] (Gen. 29); & Moses & Zipporah (Ex. 2).

Jesus names her reality but never places a moral _____ on her divorces. (Remember John 3:17?)

Jesus engages the woman who has been hurt by the institution of

marriage, has questions, and is ultimately _____ in her soul.

The woman said, "I know that the Messiah is coming, the one who is called the Christ. When he comes, he will teach everything to us."
Jesus said to her, "I Am—the one who speaks with you."
-John 4:25-26

- Who has been left behind by our institutions?
- What hurts do you carry and can bring honestly to Jesus?
- What roles do you see "Messiah" fulfilling in this story? What role do you need Jesus to fill in your life?
