Sunday, January 28, noon, Talbert Building

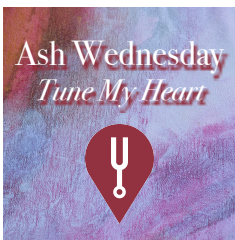

Delivery systems for Living Water:

Disciples — choose to debate philosophy/theology.

Neighbors — do not know the man born blind and cannot validate his experience.

Pharisees — reject good things done in wrong way.

Jesus heard they had expelled the man born blind. Finding him, Jesus said, "Do you believe in the Son of Man?" He answered, "Who is he, sir? I want to believe in him." Jesus said, "You have seen him. In fact, he is the one speaking with you." - John 9:35-37
