SERIES INSIGHT

In this series, **One Purpose**, we are looking at the Book of Philippians and what drives why we do what we do. Why are we here? What makes us come alive? Fuels you? Inspires you? What are you drawn or compelled by? In this series, we will discover the value of WHO our purpose is as it shapes the purpose of our WHY.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. How do you see Paul expressing contentment in all circumstances (vv. 11-13)?
 - **Life Application:** Share a time when you had to choose contentment despite challenges. How can we practice contentment in a culture that constantly pushes us to want more?
2. Why do you think Paul highlights the Philippians' generosity, and how does he describe it (vv. 14-17)?
 - **Life Application:** Who has generously supported you in a time of need? How can your group be intentional about meeting others' needs within your church or community?
3. What does verse 19 teach us about God's provision?
 - **Life Application:** How does trusting that "God will supply all your needs" change the way you face financial, emotional, or relational uncertainty?
4. How is generosity an act of worship to God?
 - **Life Application:** In what ways can you view your giving—whether time, talents, or resources—as a spiritual offering to God this week?
