## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

- 1. **Review the Message**. Looking back at your notes and upon reflecting on this weekend's message, what was your one takeaway from Sunday?
- 2. **Desire for God's Presence**: What does the psalmist express about their longing for God's presence in verses 3-4?
- 3. How would you describe your own desire for God's presence in your life?
- 4. **Metaphors of the Sparrow and Swallow**: Why do you think the psalmist uses the metaphors of the sparrow and swallow to describe their dwelling place near God's altar?
- 5. What significance do these birds hold in conveying the psalmist's feelings?
- 6. **Blessings of Dwelling in God's House**: According to the passage, what blessings are associated with dwelling in the house of the Lord?
- 7. How can we experience a sense of home and security in our relationship with God?
- 8. **Journeying Toward God**: The psalmist talks about the journey to God's dwelling place. How can this journey be applied metaphorically to our spiritual lives?
- 9. What are some practical steps we can take to draw closer to God in our daily lives?
