4. In what practical ways can we embody Jesus' message of love in our daily interactions, both within our immediate circles and in broader society?
5. How does understanding the depth of Jesus' love for humanity, as demonstrated through his teachings and actions, inspire us to love others unconditionally and sacrificially?
