DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. **Review the Message.** Looking back at your notes and upon reflecting on this weekend's message, what was your one takeaway from Sunday?
2. Did you set any New Years goals or resolutions this year? Share one with the group! If not, what is one thing you want to see happen in your own life this year?
 - **Leader Note:** Consider encouraging your group to jot their goal/resolution down and hang it up where they can see it regularly for the next few weeks. What we focus on expands. So it is with our goals/resolutions!
3. With the New Year in mind, what do you sense God is doing/wants to reveal in your life this year? Consider thinking beyond just goals/resolutions. Is there a certain word, phrase, and/or verse you sense will give you vision for 2023?
4. Thinking about this group (or family if you're doing this individually), consider these questions:
 - What do you hope this group/family to be known for this year?
 - What traits and ways of life would you want to see? How can you become that?
 - What do you want to see God do in and through your group/family this year?
5. Consider Grace Community Church.
 - What do you hope to see God do in and through Grace this year?
 - Where do you need to be awakened this year - to see how you can engage at Grace? What is the next step you will need to take?

PRAYER

Allow people to share requests and celebrate any praise reports as well. Consider having someone write down the requests to share with the group. Take time to pray however long your group needs.
