SLIDE 2 – HEBREWS 13:8 – JESUS CHRIST IS THE SAME...

SLIDES 3,4 - PSALMS 103:6-8 (s000000 many Psalms)

#### SLIDE 5 – GOD IS *DEPENDABLY* GRACIOUS (& MERCIFUL)

- Both words exclusively refer to God's character (merciful = compassionate)
- Central to our relationship w/God, through Jesus how He will be, towards us
- Character heart attitude THIS is how we KNOW we can go to Him, in need
- God, Self-described I Am who I Am I Will Be who I Will Be (state of being)
  - o THIS is how God chooses to reveal Himself to Moses (& Israel...& us)
  - When we see Him revealed in Scripture, this is who He still is the SAME
- To Moses → in (40+ year) deliverance process from Egypt friend of God

#### SLIDE 6 – WELL, THIS IS A FINE MESS (CONTEXT)

- Reg. references to Israel's 430 years of slavery in Egypt plagues & Passover
- When God re-affirmed Israel are His people & He is their God
- Rebellion, disobedience, complaining/grumbling, mistrust, defiance, idolatry
- Over 40-day period of set-apartness, God gives Moses the Torah (His Law) etc.
  - o Israel DIVES into idolatry God sends Moses (Ex 32:7) down from Mt.
  - o Discovers Israelites wild party, golden calf, 1st 3 commandments
  - o Moses angry breaks 2 stone tablets; comes down to crack some heads
  - o Confronts Aaron (& Israel) "what have you done?" I don't know
    - Some Israelites outright defiant, go to war w/Moses 3K die
- God's anger & corrections; Israel's invitation to humble repentance,
  - o Israel to deal w/consequences punishment (consequences) & plaque
- Moses back to the Mt. 40 MORE days of set-apartness → new tablets
  - o These next interactions reveal God's heart/character for His people

#### SLIDE 13 - THE LORD IS GRACIOUS & COMPASSIONATE...

- He is gracious, compassionate, slow to anger, rich in love & faithfulness
- Even in the face of His peoples' rebellion, wickedness, sin, etc...
  - o THIS isn't rooted in our inherent goodness, but in HIS
  - o God determined THIS is how He will interact with us... its our move
- What about the "not leave quilty unpunished to the 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> generation?"
  - o How do we set ourselves up for God's grace, compassion/mercy, etc...?

## SLIDES 14-20 – PROVERBS 3:32-35; JAMES 4:4,6-8a; 1PETER 5:5-7 SLIDE 21 – GRACE FOR THE HUMBLE

• God is determined to walk in relationship w/us, in spite of our *rebellion*, *wickedness*, *sin...* AS LONG AS we respond to Him in humility/repentance

- If we rebel, insist on our own way, live in pride God WILL resist/oppose us
  - o b/c pride/rebellion/doing my own thing  $\rightarrow$  running w/the devil
    - self-justification; ...'but THIS is why..."
  - o can't have self-determined relationship w/Christ only on His terms
  - o **Ephesians 2:8 –** saved by grace, not by works so none can boast...

#### SLIDE 22 – PREPARED FOR GRACE

- we can orient ourselves & our lives towards humility, teachability, repentance
- God's heart towards us is centered on relationship & overcoming our sin
  - He's already made a way for this *through* Christ
  - Christ WILL receive us from His throne of grace w/WHAT we need at the TIME we need it
- Living prepared for grace, in ALL areas of life
  - $\circ$  Embracing a humble viewpoint on life  $\rightarrow$  vs. only where self-determined
  - o He who BEGAN the good works in us will COMPLETE it as well
