SLIDE 2 – GIVE THANKS – LEAVE COMPARISON BEHIND

- Cultivating thanksgiving/being thankful comes from a place of faith
- Intentional Choices vs. Surfing our Feelings
- Don't compare self to others if you do this, your life will ALWAYS suck
 - No good is ever enough; what I have never measures up

SLIDE 3 – GET OFF THE (HEDONIC) TREADMILL

- **"THE GRATITUDE EXPERIMENT"** Hedonic treadmill phenomena describing how are real/perceived level of happiness & enjoyment of life returns to an equilibrium/baseline, no matter what awesomeness we've experienced →
 - Win lottery, get a raise at work, accomplish a goal \rightarrow back to baseline
 - Express gratitude intentionally & often get off the Hedonic treadmill
 - Key element of cultivating thanksgiving, better sense of wellbeing

SLIDE 4 – PSALM 16:5,6

SLIDE 5 - YOU ALONE - PORTION - CUP - INHERITANCE

- David no matter what other circumstances; there is nothing & there is no one else that satisfies, that is enough, that is worth pursuing the Lord God, YHWH
- YOU ALONE my portion, my cup, the One who secures my lot
 - Apportioned boundary lines of family inheritance divided by Torah w/in the families (tribes, clans, families, birth order, etc...)
- David a Hebrew from the tribe of Judah; 'pre-determined' life outcomes; sons following fathers for generations; financial security & station set
 - \circ $\;$ Anointed by God to be King, ancestor of the Messiah, the Christ
 - $\circ~$ Above all others, above all else \rightarrow David recognizes God is the prize
- **PORTION** what a person is allotted by another usually inheritance
- CUP symbol for provision (lodging, eat/drink, etc...) DITTO
- MAKE LOT SECURE decisions (oft made by rolling lots/dice) secure
- **PLEASANT BOUNDARY LINES** I like & enjoy where You, O Lord, have established for me to dwell etc... limits, YES & NO, the Way
- INHERITANCE what is passed down to me delightful (goodly)
- Contentedness; thankfulness; focus on God as the real treasure; I have enough, w/o losing any validity in comparison TO/WITH others & their portion, cup, etc

SLIDE 6 – EXODUS 20:17

SLIDE 7 - DON'T COVET - WRONG DESIRE FOR ANOTHER'S PORTION, CUP, ETC

- COVET cultivated desire for another person's stuff/etc
- Puts stuff above the Lord I don't have what I need; God is holding out on me

- Ruins our relationships, steals ability to find joy in what I have, where I am
- Lying, stealing, cheating, etc...
- E.g. Eden; brother Amnon (& Tamar); David & Bathsheba, King Ahab & Naboth; Elisha & Naaman Gehazi's greed

SLIDE 11 – LOVE YOUR NEIGHBOR *LEAVE COMPARISONS BEHIND

- Love neighbor as you love yourself; do no harm to others (as to self)
- Paul is addressing heart issues (addressed by the Torah/commands)
- Jesus' instruction (& Torah) to love one another/love neighbor
 Can't covet (cheat on, steal, lie, murder) if we love
- Comparison steals joy, contentedness; breeds mistrust of God, His provision, His plans, His purposes, His process
 - 'taking matters into our own hands'

- "Christmas time" greed, covet, lust, desire what I DON'T have & others do
- Little bit raw/real will I trust Jesus & His portion, cup, lot, inheritance for me?

 - o Joni workplace blessings & flourishish; not fair
