

# LET'S GO

## *"On the Way"*

### Acts 8:5-8, 26-38

#### Opening Icebreakers

1. Have you ever followed directions without knowing where you were going? What happened?
2. When you hear the phrase "Let's go," what emotions does that stir in you? Excitement, hesitation, anxiety, motivation? Why?

#### Digging Into Scripture

3. Read Acts 8:5–8. What was happening in Samaria before the angel interrupted Philip? Why would it have been hard to leave that moment?
4. Read Acts 8:26–27. What details does the angel give Philip? What details are missing? What does that tell us about how God often leads?
5. Read Acts 8:29–31. What stands out about the Spirit's instruction to Philip? Why do you think God simply said, "Go and stay near it"?
6. Read Acts 8:32–35. Why is Isaiah 53 such a powerful passage? How did Philip use the Scripture the eunuch was already reading?
7. Read Acts 8:36–38. What does the eunuch's urgency about baptism reveal about his heart? What changed between confusion and conviction?

#### Personal Reflection & Application

8. Where might God currently be nudging you to go, even if you don't have all the details?
9. Are you more likely to wait for full understanding or move forward in obedience? Why?
10. Who is on the "road" you're currently on? Who in your life might be spiritually curious?
11. Is there a conversation you've sensed the Spirit prompting you to have but you've been keeping your distance?
12. If you're honest, are you surrendered to Jesus or just informed about Him? What would full surrender look like?

#### Living It Out

This week, choose one intentional step:

- Pray daily for one specific person by name who may be spiritually curious.
- Initiate one spiritual conversation by asking a simple question (like Philip did).
- Invite someone to church or to sit with you next Sunday.
- If you've never been baptized after surrendering to Jesus, go public with your faith.

#### Prayer Time

Spend time praying for:

- Courage to obey even without full clarity.
- Sensitivity to the Spirit's nudges.
- Specific names of people God may want you to engage.
- Boldness to respond immediately when belief demands action.
