Digging Into Scripture

3. Read Romans 1:14–17. What words or phrases stand out to you right away?
4. Paul says he feels obligated to share the gospel (v.14). What do you think he means by that?
5. In verse 15, Paul says he is eager to preach. What's the difference between feeling obligated and feeling eager?
6. Verse 16 says the gospel is the power of God. Why is that important when it comes to sharing your faith?
7. Verse 17 talks about living "by faith." What does that actually look like in everyday life?

Personal Reflection & Application

8. Which word best describes your current approach to sharing your faith: hesitant, neutral, or eager? Why?
9. Where has God placed you right now that might be more strategic than you realize?
10. Do you see the gospel as good news worth sharing or just something you personally believe?
11. What usually holds you back from talking about Jesus...fear, awkwardness, not knowing what to say, or something else?
12. Are you more likely to trust your ability to explain things or God's power to change people?

Living It Out

13. Identify one person in your life right now who needs to hear or see the gospel. Who is it?
14. What is one simple step you could take this week...start a conversation, share your story, invite them to church, or just pray intentionally?
15. Where do you spend most of your time (work, school, gym, neighborhood)? How could you be more intentional right there?
