“As You Go”

Matthew 28:18–20

Opening Icebreakers

1. When you hear the phrase “Let’s go!” what comes to mind? A game? A big moment? Something else?
2. Who has had the most influence on your life spiritually? What did they do that impacted you?

Digging Into Scripture

3. Read Matthew 28:18–20. Why do you think Jesus begins with His authority before giving His command?
4. What does it practically mean that Jesus has “all authority in heaven and on earth”? How should that shape our response to Him?
5. The central command in this passage is to “make disciples.” How is that different from making converts or church attenders?
6. Jesus says we make disciples “as we go.” Where are the everyday places God has already positioned you to live this out?
7. Why is baptism described as a starting place rather than the finish line of discipleship?
8. What stands out to you about the phrase “teaching them to obey everything”? Why is obedience so central to discipleship?
9. How should Jesus’ promise, “I am with you always,” change the way we think about going?

Personal Reflection & Application

10. Which of these best describes you right now?
 - I am making disciples as I go.
 - I believe I should, but I hesitate.
 - I’m not sure I’m a disciple at all.
 - I’m still exploring what I believe
11. What fears or hesitations keep you from talking about Jesus more naturally in everyday life?
12. Is there someone specific God may be placing on your heart to pray for, invest in, or invite?
13. In what area of your life do you need to move from being informed to being obedient?
14. If you have never been baptized, what is holding you back from publicly declaring your allegiance to Jesus?

Living It Out:

- Pray daily this week for one person by name who does not know Jesus.
- Look for one intentional opportunity this week to start a spiritual conversation “as you go.”
- If you need to be baptized, begin that conversation this week.

Prayer Time

- Thank Jesus for His presence and ask for courage to live on mission as you go.
- Pray for the specific people God has placed in your life.
