Week 6: Jesus Saves Those Who Struggle

Weekly Summary: Do real Christians really sin? Do real Christians want to sin? If Christians love Jesus, why do they keep doing the stuff Jesus hates? Is their faith fake? Romans 7 is a transparent answer to those essential questions.

- People who struggled -
 - ✓ 1 Samuel 13:14 "But now your kingdom will not endure; the Lord has sought out a man after his own heart and appointed him ruler of his people, because you have not kept the Lord's command."
 - ✓ Matthew 16:16 Simon Peter answered, "You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God."
 - ✓ Matthew 16:23 Jesus turned and said to Peter, "Get behind me, Satan!"
 - ✓ John 11:16 Then Thomas (also known as Didymus) said to the rest of the disciples, "Let us also go, that we may die with him."
- Romans 7:15 "I do not understand what I do. For what I want to do I do not do, but what I hate I do."

Romans 7:18b - "For I have the desire to do what is good, but I cannot carry it out."

- Remember who Paul was.
 - ✓ Philippians 3:5-6 "[I was] a Hebrew of Hebrews; in regard to the law, a Pharisee;
 6 as for zeal, persecuting the church; as for righteousness based on the law,
 faultless.
 - ✓ 1 Corinthians 6:12b "I will not be mastered by anything."

Romans 8:7 - The mind governed by the flesh is hostile to God; it does not submit to God's law, nor can it do so.

Galatians 5:25 - Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit.

- ❖ Take Away 1: We have a daily <u>struggle</u>.
- Romans 7:24 "What a wretched man I am! Who will rescue me from this body that is subject to death?"
- ❖ Take Away 2: Sometimes we feel like **giving up**.
- Romans 7:25 Thanks be to God, who delivers me through Jesus Christ our Lord!

Luke 5:8 - When Simon Peter saw this, he fell at Jesus' knees and said, "Go away from me, Lord; I am a sinful man!"

John 8:4 - "Teacher, this woman was caught in the act of adultery."

Luke 7:48 - Then Jesus said to her, "Your sins are forgiven."

Hebrews 4:15 - [He] has been tempted in every way, just as we are—yet he did not sin.

- ♣ Hebrews 10:26-27 If we deliberately keep on sinning after we have received the knowledge of the truth, no sacrifice for sins is left, 27 but only a fearful expectation of judgment and of raging fire that will consume the enemies of God.
- ❖ Take Away 3: The struggle can lead us to **indifference**.
- ❖ 1 Thessalonians 5:11 Therefore encourage one another and build each other up, just as in fact you are doing.

Galatians 6:2 - Carry each other's burdens.

James 5:16 - Confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed.

❖ Take Away 4: **Help** your brother/sister with their struggles.

Points to Ponder

- 1. List some Biblical characters who struggled with sin. Comment on the change (struggle) that took place for the infant Roman Christians. Explain the struggle that takes place within us.
- 2. What is the bowling ball you carry? Why is it easy to despair at times? Comment on how Jesus did with temptation? Why is this comforting?
- 3. Why is it easy to become indifferent to sin? What's the danger? Who can you encourage in his/her struggle? Who can encourage you?
