



- Multitude in heaven saying Hallelujah!!
- Jesus returns to earth on white horse
- Believers (armies in heaven) return with him
- Armies of earth arrayed in Israel against Jesus
- Antichrist & False Prophet cast in Lake of Fire
- Rest armies killed by sword (words) of Jesus

** 2nd Coming of Jesus **

Chapter 20:1-6 Review

- Jesus reigns on the earth with believers
- Israel delivered, gathered, Spirit poured out
- Time of rest and peace (like Sabbath rest)
- Earth is full of the knowledge of the Lord
- Satan bound, Beast & False Prophet in Lake of Fire
- Temple built, water flows out from under it
- Incredible changes to the land

Rev 20:7	When the thousand years are completed, <u>Satan will be</u> released from his prison,
	and will come out <u>to deceive the nations</u> which are in the four corners of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them together for the war; <u>the number of them is like the sand of the seashore.</u>

"Sand of Seashore" -> Millions will be deceived by Satan

Despite:

- 1. 1000 years of seeing and worshipping Jesus in person
- 2. Earth being full of the knowledge of the Lord
- 3. Peace on the earth

<u>How do we know sin is still present?</u> Nations will not celebrate the Feast of Tabernacles, no rain (Zec 14)

Conclude that during Millennial Reign:

- 1. People will still be born in sin and need a Savior
- 2. Without accepting Jesus, flesh rules & Satan can tempt him
- 3. Man is still the same, must humble himself and repent



	and the dead were judged from the things which were written in the books, according to their deeds.
Rev 20:13	And the sea gave up the dead which were in it, and death and Hades gave up the dead which were in them; and they were judged, <u>every one of them according to their deeds.</u>

Jer 17:10 I test the mind,


Even to give to each man according to his ways, According to the results of his deeds.

1Cor 15:23	But each in his own order: Christ the first fruits, after that those who are Christ's at His coming,

	all authority and power.	
1Cor 15:25	For He must reign until He has put all His enemies under His feet.	
1Cor 15:26	The last enemy that will be abolished is death.
