







Spiritual vs Physical Realm

Look like?

Examples: Seeing the Spiritual Realm

- 1. Balaam's donkey speaks to him, then sees angel
- 2. Elisha prayed for his servant to see angels
- 3.4 men walking in the furnace
- 4. Jesus after being resurrected appears to disciples in spiritual body (behind shut doors)
- 5. 500 people saw Jesus ascend into heaven
- 6. Stephen seeing heaven opened before his death
- 7. Entire book of Revelation (in the Spirit on the Lord's day)

.... The Lord knows those who are His!!




.... The Holy Spirit authenticates each of us!

	our God on their foreheads."
Rev 7:4	And I heard the number of those who were sealed,
	144,000 sealed from every tribe of the sons of Israel:

Example 2 -- Jesus Sealed

Joh 6:27"Do not work for the food which perishes, but for the
food which endures to eternal life, which the Son of
Man will give to you, for on Him the Father, God,
has set His seal."

Luk 11:36	"If therefore your whole body is full of light, with no dark part in it, it will be wholly illumined, as when the lamp illumines you with its rays."


This is the message we have heard from Him and 1Joh 1:5 announce to you, that <u>God is Light</u>, and in Him there is <u>no darkness</u> at all.

in the darkness, but will have the Light of life."


...to open their eyes so that they may <u>turn from</u> Act 26:18 darkness to light and from the dominion of Satan

to God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins...


Eph 5:8 for at one time <u>you were darkness</u>, but <u>now you</u> <u>are light</u> in the Lord. Walk as children of light




Darkness Absence of Satan, rulers, Light powers, etc.

When is one "Born of Spirit"?

Eph 1:13	 In Him (Christ), you also, 1. <u>after listening to the message of truth</u>, the gospel of your salvation— 2. <u>having also believed</u>, 3. <u>you were sealed in Him with the Holy Spirit of promise</u>,
Eph 1:14	who is given as a pledge of our inheritance, with a view to the redemption of God's own possession, to the praise of His glory.

When is one "Born of Spirit"?

But <u>to all who believed him and accepted him</u> , he gave the right to become children of God.
They are reborn—not with a physical birth resulting from human passion or plan, <u>but a birth that comes</u> from God.

When were the disciples "Born of Spirit"?

Luke 22:28	"You are those who have stood by Me in My trials;
	and just as My Father has granted Me a kingdom, I
LUKE ZZ.Z9	and just as My Father has granted Me a kingdom, I grant you
Luke 22:30	that you may eat and drink at My table in My kingdom, and
	that you may eat and drink <u>at My table in My kingdom</u> , and you will sit on thrones judging the twelve tribes of Israel.

Matt 16:13	Now when Jesus came into the district of Caesarea Philippi, He was asking His disciples, "Who do people say that the Son of Man is?"
Matt 16:16	Simon Peter answered, "You are the Christ, the Son of
	the living God."
Matt 16:19	" <mark>I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven</mark> ; …

If the disciples were born of spirit / sealed at the time they believed,

why were they told to wait in Jerusalem for the promise of the Spirit?

Passover -> Jesus crucified

First Fruits -> Jesus' resurrection

40 days after resurrection → Jesus ascended to heaven

Pentecost (50 days) → Holy Spirit given

Waiting on the Spirit

John	So Jesus said to them again, "Peace be with you; as the

John	And when He had said this, He breathed on them and		
20:22	said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit.		
John	"If you forgive the sins of any, their sins have been forgiven		
20:23	them; if you retain the sins of any, they have been retained."		

John	But Thomas, one of the twelve, called Didymus, was not with		
20:24	them when Jesus came.		
	So the other disciples were saying to him, "We have seen the		
John	Lord!" But he said to them, "Unless I see in His hands the		
20:25	imprint of the nails, and put my finger into the place of the		
	nails, and put my hand into His side, <u>I will not believe</u> ."		
John	After eight days His disciples were again inside, and Thomas with		
20:26	them. Jesus came, the doors having been shut, and stood in their		
20.20	midst and said, "Peace be with you."		
John	Then He said to Thomas, "Reach here with your finger, and		
20:27	see My hands; and reach here your hand and put it into My		
20.27	side; and do not be unbelieving, but believing."		

John	Thomas answered and said to Him, "My Lord and my	
20:28	God!"	
John	Jesus said to him, "Because you have seen Me, have you	
20:29	believed? Blessed are they who did not see, and yet	
20:29	believed."	
John	Therefore many other signs Jesus also performed in the	
20:30	presence of the disciples, which are not written in this	
20.30	book;	
John	but these have been written so that you may believe	
20:31	that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that	
20.31	believing you may have life in His name.

Believers were to receive the Spirit	Ok
Not sent yet because Jesus not glorified	Not glorified in heaven

John And when He had said this, <u>He breathed on them</u> and 20:22 said to them, <u>Receive the Holy Spirit.</u>

1. Passage context is about believing... Blessed are they who did not see, and yet believed."

2. Jesus breathed ON them

3. Might be the seal of the Holy Spirit ON the disciples...the verification of authenticity?
