Why are the 144,000 Sealed by Holy Spirit?

Rom 11:25 For I do not want you, brethren, to be uninformed of this mystery—so that you will not be wise in your own estimation—that a <u>partial hardening has happened to</u> <u>Israel until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in</u>;

- **1. Rapture concludes Time of Gentiles**
- 2. Tribulation = 70th Week of Daniel 9 Prophecy

>>> Tribulation is about Israel <<<

- 3. Sealing the 144k reverses the hardening on Israel
- 4. Return to OT methodology regarding Holy Spirit

2 Th 2:1	Now we request you, brethren, with regard to the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ and our gathering together to Him,




