



1. Main References to the Rapture

1Cor 15:51	Behold, I tell you a <u>mystery; we</u> will not all <u>sleep</u> , but we will all be changed,
1Cor 15:52	in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet; for the trumpet will sound, and the <u>dead will be raised imperishable</u> , and <u>we will be changed</u> .

1. Main References to the Rapture

1 Th 4:13	But we do not want you to be uninformed, brethren, about those who are asleep, so that you will not grieve as do the rest who have no hope.
1 Th 4:14	For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so God will bring with Him those who have fallen asleep in Jesus.
1 Th 4:15	For this we say to you by the word of the Lord, that we who are alive and remain until the coming of the Lord, will not precede those who have fallen asleep.
1 Th 4:16	For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first.

5. Rapture vs 2nd Coming

Rapture

Then we who are alive and remain will be <u>caught up</u> 1 Th 4:17 together with them <u>in the clouds to meet the Lord in the</u> <u>air</u>, and so we shall always be with the Lord.

2nd Coming

Zec 14:4	In that day <u>His feet will stand on the Mount of Olives</u> ,
	which is in front of Jerusalem on the east; and the
	Mount of Olives will be split in its middle from east to
	west by a very large valley, so that half of the mountain
	will move toward the north and the other half toward
	the south.

6. Resurrection Order

Rev 20:4	Then I saw thrones, and they sat on them, and judgment was given to them. And I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded because of their testimony of Jesus and because of the word of God, and those who had not worshiped the beast or his image, and had <u>not received the</u> <u>mark</u> on their forehead and on their hand; and <u>they came to</u> <u>life and reigned with Christ for a thousand years.</u>
Rev 20:5	The rest of the dead did not come to life until the thousand years were completed. This is the first resurrection.
Rev 20:6	Blessed and holy is the one who has a part in the first resurrection; over these the <u>second death</u> has no power, but they will be priests of God and of Christ and will reign with Him for a thousand years.

7 Reasons Why The Rapture Occurs at Beginning of The Tribulation

1. Churches Not Spoken of Again Except:

"I, Jesus, have sent My angel to testify to you theseRev 22:16things for the churchesdescendant of David, the bright morning star."

18 times in Chapters 1-3

2. Trumpet Sound

Rev 4:1	After these things I looked, and behold, a door standing open in heaven, and <u>the first voice which I had heard, like the</u> <u>sound of a trumpet</u> speaking with me, said, "Come up here, and I will show you what must take place after these things."
Rev 1:10	I was in the Spirit on the Lord's day, and <u>I heard behind me a</u> loud voice like the sound of a trumpet,
1 Th 4:16	For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first.
1Cor 15:52	in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, <u>at the last trumpet; for</u> the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised imperishable, and we will be changed.

3. Context from Laodicean Church Age

Rev 3:2	⁶ Behold, <u>I stand at the door and knock</u> ; if anyone hears My voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and will dine with him, and he with Me.
Rev 3:2	1 'He who overcomes, I will grant to him to sit down with Me on My throne, as I also overcame and sat down with My Father on His throne.
Rev 3:2	2 'He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches."
Rev 4:1	After these things I looked, and behold, <u>a door standing open in heaven</u> , and the first voice which I had heard, like the sound of a trumpet speaking with me, said, "Come up here, and I will show you what must take place after these things."
Rev 4:2	Immediately I was in the Spirit; and behold, <u>a throne was standing in</u> heaven, and One sitting on the throne.

4. Promise to Overcoming Church

Because you have kept the word of My perseverance, <u>I also will</u> Rev 3:10 keep you from the hour of testing, that hour which is about to come upon the whole world, to test those who dwell on the earth.

5. Not Destined for Wrath

1Th 5:2	For you yourselves know full well that <u>the day of the Lord will</u> come just like a thief in the night.
1Th 5:9	For <u>God has not destined us for wrath</u> , but for obtaining salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ,
1Th 5.10	who died for us, <u>so that whether we are awake or asleep, we will</u>

live together with Him.

6. How Could it be a Surprise During the Tribulation

Rapture will be: → Unannounced & Shocking → As a thief in the night

4th Seal -- War, famine, pestilence & wild animals

-- Death and Hades given power over 1/4 part of the earth

5th Seal -- Martyrs, killed because of the Word of God and their testimony

6th Seal -- Incredible earthquake, sun blackened, moon like blood

-- Stars in sky fall to the earth

-- Every mountain and island moved out of place

... Then comes the trumpets and bowls of wrath that are even worse

7. Marriage of the Lamb

Rev 19:7	"Let us rejoice and be glad and give the glory to Him, for the marriage of the Lamb has come and His bride has made herself ready."
Rev 19:8	It was given to her to clothe herself in fine linen, bright and clean; for the fine linen is the righteous acts of the saints.
Rev 19:9	Then he *said to me, "Write, ' <u>Blessed are those who are</u> invited to the marriage supper (feast) of the Lamb.'" And he *said to me, "These are true words of God."
