Inspiration verses:

1 Cor 3:11	For no man can lay a <u>foundation</u> other than the one which is laid, which <u>is</u> <u>Jesus Christ</u> .
1 Cor 3:12	Now if any man builds on the foundation with gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straw,
1 Cor 3:13	each man's work will become evident; for the day will show it because it is to be revealed with fire, and the fire itself will test the quality of each man's work.
1 Cor 3:14	If any man's work which he has built on it remains, he will receive a reward.
1 Cor 3:15	If any man's work is burned up, he will suffer loss; but he himself will be saved, yet so as through fire.

3 Thoughts:

- Eternal investments have the best payoff because of the duration.
- Eternal perspective is the hardest to maintain because it's farthest away.
- 2020 has shown how easy it is to get wrapped up in short terms problems.

Book of Revelation

- 22 chapters -- 19 are about future events
- Chronological book -- gives incredible context about future by order
- Final book -- provides tie-points for previous 65 books
- One true author -- consistent with other 65 books, defines itself
- Blessed -- to read, hear and heed

Rev 1:3 Blessed is he who <u>reads</u> and those who <u>hear</u> the words of the prophecy, and <u>heed</u> the things which are written in it; for the time is near.

Major questions Christians have about future:

- 1 Are we in The Tribulation?
- When does the rapture occur? (pre-, mid-, post-tribulation, what date?)
- 3 Who is the antiChrist?
- What is the mark of the beast and what does 666 mean? Is the mark a vaccine or chip?
- 5 Should I be preparing bunkers, weapons, food and supplies to survive?
- What happens to my friends and family who don't know Jesus during the Tribulation?
- What should I do differently today about the end times?

Are We in The Tribulation?

...during 4th Seal Judgment

Rev 6:8	I looked, and behold, an ashen horse; and he who sat on it had the name
	Death; and Hades was following with him. Authority was given to them
	over a fourth of the earth, to kill with sword and with famine and
	with pestilence and by the wild beasts of the earth.

...during 6th Trumpet Judgment

Rev 9:18	A third of mankind was killed by these three plagues, by the fire and the
	smoke and the brimstone which proceeded out of their mouths.








3,334,500,000 people killed in the tribulation (50% of remaining) from 2 judgments

C. Millienial Reign of Jesus

Rev 20:2	And he laid hold of the dragon, the serpent of old, who is the devil and Satan, and bound him for a thousand years;
Rev 20:3	and he threw him into the abyss, and shut <i>it</i> and sealed <i>it</i> over him, so that he would not deceive the nations any longer, until the thousand years were completed; after these things he must be released for a short time.
Rev 20:4	Then I saw thrones, and they sat on them, and judgment was given to them. And I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded because of their testimony of Jesus and because of the word of God, and those who had not worshiped the beast or his image, and had not received the mark on their forehead and on their hand; and they came to life and reigned with Christ for a thousand years.
Rev 20:5	The rest of the dead did not come to life until the thousand years were completed. This is the first resurrection.
Rev 20:6	Blessed and holy is the one who has a part in the first resurrection; over these the second death has no power, but they will be priests of God and of Christ and will reign with Him for a thousand years.
Rev 20:7	When the thousand years are completed, Satan will be released from his prison,

	day.


7 Days = 7000 Years

Creation 6 days of creation/work by God; God rested on the 7th day


Law 6 days of work; 1 day of rest (Sabbath)

Rev 1:1	The Revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave Him to show to His
	bond-servants, the things which must soon take place; and He sent
	and communicated it by His angel to His bond-servant John,
Rev 1:2	who testified to the word of God and to the testimony of Jesus Christ,
	even to all that he saw.

"Revelation" = G602 apokalypsis

Strong's Outline of Biblical Usage:

- A. a disclosure of truth, instruction
 - I. concerning things before unknown
 - II. used of events by which things or states or persons hitherto withdrawn from view are made visible to all
- B. manifestation, appearance

Rev 1:17	When I saw Him, I fell at His feet like a dead man. And He placed His right hand on me, saying, "Do not be afraid; I am the first and the last,
	and the living One; and I was dead, and behold, I am alive forevermore, and I have the keys of death and of Hades.

.....Why would John fall down in front of Jesus "like a dead man"?

...End of Nebuchadnezzar's dream...

Dan 2:34	"You continued looking until a <u>stone was cut out without hands</u> , and it struck the statue on its feet of iron and clay and crushed them.
Dan 2:35	"Then the iron, the clay, the bronze, the silver and the gold were crushed all at the same time and became like chaff from the summer threshing floors; and the wind carried them away so that not a trace of them was found. But the stone that struck the statue became a great mountain and filled the whole earth.
Dan 2:44	"In the days of those kings the <u>God of heaven will set up a kingdom</u> which will never be destroyed, and that kingdom will not be left for another people; it will crush and put an end to all these kingdoms, but it will itself endure forever.

The Stone Kingdom will:


- crush all previous kingdoms, nothing left
