Introduction

Joshua 24:14-15 NASB

¹⁴"Now, therefore, fear the Lord and serve Him in sincerity and truth; and put away the gods which your fathers served beyond the River and in Egypt, and serve the Lord. ¹⁵If it is disagreeable in your sight to serve the Lord, choose for yourselves today whom you will serve: whether the gods which your fathers served which were beyond the River, or the gods of the Amorite in whose land you are living; **but as for me and my house we will serve the Lord.**"

Judges 2:6-12 NASB

⁶When Joshua had dismissed the people, the sons of Israel went each to his inheritance to possess the land. ⁷The **people served the** Lord all the days of Joshua, and all the days of the elders who survived Joshua. who had seen all the great work of the Lord which He had done for Israel. ⁸Then Joshua the son of Nun, the servant of the Lord, died at the age of one hundred and ten. ⁹And thev buried him in the territory if his inheritance in Timnath-heres, in the hill country of Ephraim, north of Mount Gaash. ¹⁰All that generation also were gathered to their fathers; and there arose another generation after them who did not know the Lord, nor yet the work which He had done for Israel. "Then the sons of Israel did evil in the sight of the Lord and served Baals, ¹² and they forsook the Lord, the God of their fathers, who had brought them out of the land of Equpt. and followed other gods from among the gods of the peoples who were around them, and bowed themselves down to them; thus they provoked the Lord to anger.
