Introduction

Luke 1:18-25 NET

¹⁸Zechariah said to the angel, "How can I be sure of this? For I am an old man, and my wife is old as well." 19The angel answered him, "I am Gabriel, who stands in the presence of God, and I was sent to speak to you and to bring you this good news. ²⁰And now, because you did not believe my words, which will be fulfilled in their time, you will be silent, unable to speak, until the day these things take place." ²¹Now the people were waiting for Zechariah, and they began to wonder why he was delayed in the Holy Place. ²²When he came out, he was not able to speak to them. They realized that he had seen a vision in the Holy Place, because he was making signs to them and remained unable to speak. ²³When his time of service was over, he went to his home. ²⁴After some time his wife Elizabeth became pregnant, and for five months she kept herself in seclusion. She said, ²⁵"This is what the Lord has done for me at the time when he has been gracious to me, to take away my disgrace among people."
