- The Book of Psalms, or the Psalter, is a collection of songs and poetry complied for both personal and national worship. They date from the time of Moses (Psalm 90) to the Captivity (Psalm 137). The book is a marvelous example of Hebrew poetry and served as the Temple hymn book in the Kingdom period.
- It is divided into Five Books or Groupings (1-41; 42-72; 73-89; 90-106; 107-150) with each closing with a doxology. These Five Books correspond to the five books of the Torah. As the Torah is God <u>revealing</u> Himself and His will to His people, the Psalms are His people's <u>response</u>. It is properly called, <u>answering speech</u>.
- Consequently, the Psalter is not simply or primarily a <u>book</u> to be <u>outlined</u>, but a <u>companion</u> with which we <u>engage</u>, <u>personally</u> and <u>profoundly</u>. It is the <u>saint's</u> <u>song</u> book. It is the <u>pilgrim's</u> prayer book.
