"And he found a Jew named Aquila, a native of Pontus, having recently come from Italy with his wife Priscilla, because Claudius had commanded all the Jews to leave Rome." (v. 2)

## 2. THE UNCHANGING PURPOSE THAT GUIDED HIM: (v. 5-8)

"But when Silas and Timothy came down from Macedonia, **Paul began devoting himself completely to the word**, solemnly testifying to the Jews that Jesus was the Christ...."

# 3. THE UNFAILING PROMISE THAT SUSTAINED HIM: (v. 9-11)

"<u>Do not be afraid</u>, but go on speaking and do not be silent, <u>for I am with you</u>, and no one will attack you to harm you, for I have many in this city who are my people..."

#### 4. THE UNEXPECTED PRONOUNCEMENT THAT DELIVERED HIM: (v. 12-17)

"...<u>I am unwilling to be a judge of these matters</u>." And he drove them away from the judgment seat. ...Gallio was not concerned about any of these things."
