INTRODUCTION:

REVISITING THE HEART OF THE LETTER

1. PAUL'S PRESENT CONDITION: THE ______ WHICH HE WRITES: • He is temporarily in prison, but continually on mission.

"Paul, a prisoner of Christ Jesus,..." (v. 1, 9)

2. PAUL'S PRIMARY CONCERN: THE ______ WHICH HE WRITES:

• It's Focus: "Receive Onesimus and refresh my heart."

"If then you regard me a partner, <u>accept [receive] him</u> as you would me.... Yes, brother, let me benefit from you in the Lord; <u>refresh my heart in Christ</u>."

• It's Force: "For loves's sake..."

"Therefore, though I have enough confidence in Christ to order you to do what is proper, yet <u>for love's sake</u> I rather <u>appeal to you</u>...

• The ultimate motive for service and gospel obedience is not obligation, but affection.
