A BIBLICAL THEOLOGY OF THE CREATOR: The focus of the creation narrative is not ___ ___, but _ 1. We begin to understand something about His eternality! 2. We begin to understand something about His capability! 3. We begin to understand something about His personality! 4. We begin to understand something about His **ontology**! A BIBLICAL THEOLOGY OF CREATION: 1. Creation is a **theological** issue, not a **scientific** issue. 2. Creation was a brief series of monumental, supernatural, instantaneous miracles that cannot be explained by science. But once created, it can be examined, explored and employed by science. 3. The earth has been **shaped** and **reshaped** by **universal** and **hydraulic** cataclysmic events. The first of these events brought into existence a **mature** creation with the appearance and reality of age. 4. Creation is an issue of Scriptural authority, veracity and fidelity. It is the first test of Scripture. AN OVERVIEW OF THE SIX DAY DRAMA OF CREATION: (GENESIS 1:3-2:3): 1. There is a **Person** in the drama. Don't miss Him! 2. There is a **perplexity** in the drama. Don't remove it! 3. There is a purpose in the drama. Don't rush over it! 4. There is a pattern in the drama. Don't ignore it! 5. There is a **polemic** in the drama. Don't overlook it! 6. There is a **progression** in the drama. Don't revise it! • The present creation, though it clearly, convincingly and continually declares the glory of the God, is <u>cursed</u>, <u>corrupt</u> and <u>crying out</u> in anticipation of its future deliverance.

"Therefore, just as through one man sin entered into the world, and death through sin, and death spread to all me, because all sinned..."

- The Introduction of **Corruption** and **Conflict** come as a consequence of God's **Curse**.
- Paradise Lost What man briefly enjoyed in the original creation before the Fall the unmediated presence of God and the unprecedented absence of shame—was immediately forfeited by man's disobedience.
- We will never understand the ultimate **remedy** that the world needs unless we understand the fundamental **malady** that the world suffers. If the true condition is **misdiagnosed** then it is hopelessly incurable.

But Corruption and Conflict are also accompanied by the extraordinary expression of God's
 <u>Compassion</u>: —the <u>Postponement</u> of Full and Final Judgment, the <u>Provision</u> of Temporary
 Covering and Approach to God, and the <u>Promise</u> of a Seed and Ultimate Triumph.

"I will establish My covenant between Me and you and your descendants after you throughout their generations for an everlasting covenant, to be God to you and to your descendants after you."

—Genesis 17:7

"Remember that you were at that time separate from Christ, excluded from the commonwealth of Israel, and strangers to the covenants of promise, having no hope and without God in the world."

—Ephesians 2:12

- Covenants form the basis of God's <u>relationship</u> with His Creation and especially mankind, providing a <u>framework</u> for all of <u>history</u>. A proper understanding of this covenantal character of history and the Old Testament is essential in the development of a biblical theology as well as a full understanding of the significance of the coming of Christ and the New Testament.
- The Covenants contained within the Old Testament collection of 39 books provide the <u>Foundation</u> (Pentateuch), <u>Formation</u> (History), <u>Aspiration</u> (Poetry), and the <u>Expectation</u> (Prophecy) of God's people.
 - God... <u>establishes</u>, <u>makes</u>, <u>remembers</u>, and <u>keeps</u> covenant. (Gen. 6:18; 9:9, 15; Exodus 2:24; Leviticus 26:42; Deuteronomy 7:9; Nehemiah 9:32; Daniel 9:4)
 - Man... <u>makes</u>, <u>keeps</u>, <u>breaks</u>, <u>forgets</u>, and <u>forsakes</u> covenant. (Gen. 6:18; 9:9, 15; Ex. 6:4; 19:5; Lev. 26:15; Deut. 29:9; 4:23, 31; 31:15; 2 Kings 17:38)
- God's Covenant with Abraham is <u>unconditional</u>, based upon a <u>promise</u>, maintained by <u>faithfulness</u> and expressed in <u>sacrificial</u> commitment.
