Three Fundamental Truths or Presuppositions:

Five Fundamental Questions:

- 1. The Question of **Origins**: Why is there something instead of nothing?
- 2. The Question of **Purpose**: Why are we here?
- 3. The Question of **Evil** (Suffering): What went wrong?
- 4. The Question of Solution (Remedy): How can it be fixed?
- 5. The Question of **Consummation** (Eschatology) : Where is it all headed?
