"Our Singular Assignment: The Ministry of Reconciliation"

(2 Corinthians 5:14-21)

INTRODUCTION:

PREVIOUSLY, FROM EPHESIANS 2:11-22:

"...[that He] might reconcile them both in one body to God through the cross..."

—Ephesians 2:16

"...for through Him we both have our access in one Spirit to the Father."

—Ephesians 2:18

- 1. <u>REMEMBER</u> What You Were ("formerly"): <u>EXCLUDED</u> (2:11, 12) "Therefore <u>remember</u>, that <u>formerly</u> you, the Gentiles in the flesh,..."
- 2. <u>RECOGNIZE</u> What He's Done ("But Now"): <u>RECONCILED</u> (2:13-18)

"<u>But now</u> in Christ Jesus you... have been brought near by the blood of Christ..."

2A.	AS AMBASSADORS, WE HAVE ONE ULTIMATE: (5:19-20)
	"namely, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not counting their
	trespasses against them, and He has committed to us the word of reconciliationas though
	God were making an appeal through us; we beg you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God."
	• We need to see evangelism not primarily as something we do Him,
	but something He doesus.
3A.	AS AMBASSADORS, WE HAVE ONE ULTIMATE: (5:14-15)
	"For <u>the love of Christ controls us</u> , having concluded this, that one died for all, therefore all
	died; and He died for all, so that they who live might no longer live for themselves, but for Him
	who died and rose again on their behalf."
