INTRODUCTION:

- The 1st Half (1:1-14) of the author's argument regarding Jesus' superiority over angels as both mediator and messenger focuses upon His Deity.
- The 2nd Half (2:5-18) of the author's argument regarding Jesus' superiority over angels as both mediator and messenger focuses upon His Humanity.

HE IS GREATER THAN THE ANGELS BECAUSE ...

1....He is the Rightful Ruler of the World to Come. (2:5-9)

-Dominion given to and lost by the first Adam. Dominion restored by the second Adam.

- 2....He is the Life-Giving Liberator of the World to Come. (2:10-16)
- 3. ... He is the Merciful Mediator of the World to Come. (2:17-18)
